The Committee on Psychotherapist Associates' primary task is to advance psychodynamic psychotherapy via education, outreach and networking opportunities for psychodynamic psychotherapists. We provide psychotherapy associates with educational programming, an online and printed national directory, an active psychotherapist associate list serve, referral opportunities, and reduced meeting registration fees. Continuing education programs include a twice yearly Discussion Group, "Psychotherapist Associates Present;" and the Committee-Sponsored Workshop on "The Business of Practice: Building and Maintaining a Psychoanalytic Psychotherapy Practice."

The Committee collaborates with other APsaA groups, including the fellowship program, psychoanalytic foundation, public information committee, research department and student/resident associates. We distribute information about local psychotherapy training/education and psychoanalytically oriented organizations.
