

New AMS Portal Announcement

We are pleased to introduce you to APsaA's new (and much improved) Association Management System (AMS) portal.

Going forward, this portal will be where you can take care of APsaA transactions, including:

- Registration/payment for APsaA meetings
- Dues and Renewal payments
- Review committee assignments
- Review contact information, demographics, etc.
- Make a donation

Your first steps to using the AMS portal involve your password. Here are the instructions:

1. The <u>first time</u> you access the portal you must reset your password. Please use this link:

https://apsaa.users.membersuite.com/auth/portal-reset-password

Access is based on the email address you currently have on file. The requested UserID is your email address (do not enter the 'numerical' APsaA ID here).

- Note: You are already in the system and access is based on the email address you currently have on file. If you enter an email address and nothing comes up for you, then please contact membership@apsa.org; you may have an old email address on file. Please do not create a new profile as it will not be linked to your membership.
- 2. Once you have reset your password you can access the Portal by clicking this link and then clicking on the Head Silhouette to Login:


