NATIONAL DIRECTORY OF INSTRUCTORS

In response to requests from many Directors of Training at APsA Psychoanalytic Institutes and Centers, as well as from informal conversations, the Department of Psychoanalytic Education (DPE) has instituted a new and creative project.

Some institutes cannot find instructors to teach specific courses needed by their candidates, or lack a particular expertise within their faculty, while other institutes simply do not have a sufficient pool of instructors to draw on to sustain their curricula. The DPE has, therefore, created a ***National Directory of Instructors***, consisting of faculty willing to teach courses via video conferencing and/or in person at Institutes and Centers in need of instructors for their curricular offerings. The DPE is thus able to assist all APsA approved institutes to supplement their curricula, and provide candidates with an excellent didactic component to their education.

Those included in this Directory are not committed to teach at any particular time or at any particular institute. They are willing to be contacted by an institute in need of an instructor. All subsequent arrangements are then made between the instructor and the institute. Institutes may request a cv, a sample syllabus, and/or teaching evaluations from the instructors listed here.
