For First Time attendees, conference registration fee will also be waived, which is an additional savings of \$200. This scholarship is an opportunity for an APsA Psychoanalyst-In-Training member# to attend the National Meeting in order to learn and experience first-hand what the APsA community has to offer. In order to receive the travel scholarship, the one requirement is that you must attend the Candidates' Council meeting on Thursday morning, February 8, 2024. A limited number of travel scholarships are available and will be allocated on a first come first serve basis.

## TO APPLY

- 1. Complete form:** Click [here](#) to complete the online form by **January 5, 2024** (Travel Scholarships are only available during Pre-Registration and not on-site.) If approved, an email will be sent to you. *For first time attendees a special registration code will be emailed to use when registering online. Do not register for the meeting until you receive the code.*
- 2. Attend:** Your attendance is required at the Thursday, February 8, 2024, meeting of the Candidates' Council from 8:15 AM to 11 AM. In order to receive your \$750\* scholarship, attendance at the entire CC meeting is mandatory. Be sure to sign the official Travel Scholarship attendance sheet.
- 3. Check your mailbox:** Following the National meeting, checks will be mailed to the members who attended the February 8th Candidates' Council Meeting (checks are mailed within 4-6 weeks from the meeting).

\*Psychoanalysts-In-Training at the APsA institutes in New York will receive \$150 in Travel Scholarship funds for the 2024 National Meeting. #This opportunity is for APsA Psychoanalyst-In-training (Candidate) Members or Academic-in-Training members whose membership is in good standing.
