In addition, the conference registration fee will be waived, which is an additional savings of \$200. This scholarship is a one-time opportunity for an APsA psychotherapy trainee member to attend the National Meeting in order to learn first-hand what the APsA community has to offer. Eligibility is for APsA Psychotherapist-in-Training Clinical Members attending their first meeting as a psychotherapy trainee. **In order to receive the travel scholarship, the one requirement is that you must attend the Candidates' Council meeting on Thursday morning, February 8, 2024.** There are very limited psychotherapy travel scholarships which will be allocated on a first come, first served basis.
