STATEMENT OF OBJECTIVES

This 2-hour virtual session includes a constructive exploration of both the relationship of antisemitism to the theories and practices of the field, and how they connect, historically and interpersonally, with white supremacy and antiblack racism specifically, and issues raised by different forms of racism in relation to psychoanalysis.

After attending, participants will be able to:

- 1. Demonstrate a deeper understanding of the historical roots and manifestations of antisemitism and racism, within the context of psychoanalysis.
- 2. Analyze and enhance their awareness of subtle forms of bias and discrimination in their clinical practice to act ethically in the field of antisemitism and racism.
- 3. Apply this knowledge to adaptations of clinical technique, broadening in their lines of inquiry and perception of intrapsychic and interpersonal racialized clinical dynamics.
