

**REQUIREMENTS FOR APsA PSYCHOTHERAPIST MEMBERSHIP:**

**Independently licensed clinician with 2 years of patient-centered work (patient-centered work can include graduate school/nursing school/medical residency experience).**

<b>SUBSTANTIAL EQUIVALENCY - for APsA Psychotherapy Programs</b>	
Course Work	<p><i>An hourly requirement that is equal to the total number of CEs required by one's state for one's professional license. (Thus, there will be differences in the number of hours required, depending on one's degree type and state of licensure.)</i></p> <p><i>Activities that would count toward the hourly requirement:</i></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"><li><i>-Courses/conference seminars on psychoanalytic work</i></li><li><i>-Psychoanalytic study group with some structure/reading list</i></li><li><i>-Teaching psychoanalytic theory or practice,</i></li><li><i>-Participating in psychoanalytic psychotherapy curriculum development or training</i></li><li><i>-Supervising graduate students or residents in psychoanalytic psychotherapy</i></li><li><i>-Publishing scholarly clinical articles about psychoanalytic psychotherapy/psychoanalysis</i></li></ul>
Supervision	<p><i>Supervision as required for your independent licensure.</i></p>
Personal Analysis/Personal Psychoanalytic Psychotherapy	<p><i>Strongly recommended.</i></p>
