STATEMENT OF OBJECTIVES

This symposium highlights the rich history and contemporary renewal of child psychoanalysis in Boston and features in-depth clinical case presentations addressing dissociation, aggression, play, trauma, and gender identity in children and adolescents. Open to therapists of all disciplines and experience levels, the program examines complex cases involving behavioral dysregulation, gender dysphoria, eating disorders, and depression, with a focus on the interpersonal dilemmas that emerge when trauma complicates the therapeutic relationship. Presenters will share innovative treatment approaches and practical strategies to expand participants' clinical skills and deepen their capacity to engage and support vulnerable youth.

1. Identify coping skills that can help school age children who have significant issues with aggression.
2. Identify two ways dissociative symptoms present in a teenager and how to teach skills to the teens to help reduce their symptoms.
